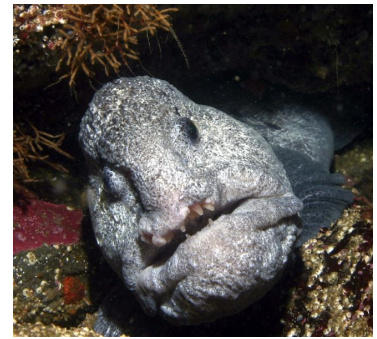


Reef Fish and Reef Creature Identification Course
